GREEN BAY, Wis. – Nominations are now open for the Nancy Armbrust Impact Award. The award was created by Schreiber Foods, and honors Nancy Armbrust, a retired Schreiber Foods executive, community advocate and leader.

The annual award recognizes women who have made a lasting impact to our community.

In partnership, Schreiber Foods and the Greater Green Bay Community Foundation, awards a grant of \$5,000 to the recipient's nonprofit organization of choice through the Women's Fund biannual grant cycle.

Community members are invited to nominate a woman who meets the following criteria:

- Actively assists others, particularly women, in realizing their full leadership potential.
- Empowers women and inspires girls by being a role model for others to emulate.
- Creates an environment in an organization that values women's accomplishments and contributions.
