GREEN BAY, WI — Brown County United Way is excited to announce that they will be hosting a Free Tax Assistance Prepping service on March 29, 2024, from 9:00 am to 2:00 pm. This service, provided through the Tax-Aide program of the AARP Foundation, is open to individuals of all ages and income levels. No AARP membership is required to access this free assistance.

Certified by the IRS and thoroughly trained, tax preparers will be available on-site at the Brown County United Way offices located at 112 N. Adams Street, Green Bay (first floor). Throughout the day, they will work with clients individually to process their taxes accurately and efficiently.

To participate in this free service, individuals must schedule an appointment in advance and pick up a tax preparation packet prior to their scheduled appointment time. Appointments can be scheduled by calling (920) 593-4764. If necessary, please leave a message, and our team will promptly return your call. Due to limited availability, we encourage early sign-ups to secure your spot.
