Appleton, WI (October 5, 2024) - On October 4 and 5, Bergstrom Automotive hosted Drive for A Cure in Appleton, Green Bay and Oshkosh to support breast cancer research programs in Wisconsin. This year, the events raised \$40,750. Of that amount, \$32,500 was generated from guest test drives and \$8,250 from donations and social media initiatives.
