The project, which focused on major upgrades and expansion of both the Main Clubhouse and the Sports Center, provides members and guests with an upscale yet relaxed atmosphere unlike anywhere else in Northeast Wisconsin.

Miron Construction Co., Inc., the official provider of construction services for the Green Bay Packers and Lambeau Field, served as the general contractor. Eppstein Uhen Architects (EUA), designer of the Milwaukee Bucks' Fiserv Forum, served as the architect.

The renovation adds to Green Bay's growing reputation as a top place to live in the United States.

Jerry Geiger, general manager of the Green Bay Country Club, commented that calls from people interested in relocating to Green Bay have risen the past several years.
