Featuring accommodations that provide comfort and peace of mind, Dimensions Living Green Bay is proud to provide a community to its assisted living residents. The resident-focused, inclusive community is pet-friendly without breed or size specific restrictions.

When a new potential resident visits, Dimensions Living team members work one-on-one with them and their families to learn what they are looking for and determine if Dimensions Living Green Bay is right for them.

“We’re working in their home,” says Janessa Raynier, Director of Marketing and Sales at Dimensions Living Green Bay. “We offer home-like settings versus a ‘shared room’. We offer full apartments, featuring a kitchen, bathroom, laundry, controlled heating, and air conditioning.”

The apartments come in one bed/bath, two bed/one bath, and two bed/two bath layouts. Residents are also able to take advantage of wellness programs, gardening areas, healthy snacks available around the clock, as well as an on-site beauty shop.

In addition to the living amenities, Dimensions Living encourages residents to build their own community with dining services, monthly programs, and volunteer opportunities. Staff are openly engaged with the residents and strive for an environment with open communication. Each resident can meet with department heads to go over any concerns. Program managers meet with residents monthly to discuss the type of events and activities that they enjoy or would like to have added to the schedule.

When asked what makes Dimensions Living Green Bay special, Raynier responded with, “When you walk into the building, you get a welcoming feeling. Team members are warm and compassionate people; even the residents are welcoming new people! The residents are involved in everything that happens here.”

Residents can participate in several age-appropriate events each month—with a new events schedule planned monthly. Events include outings with provided transportation and weekly live performances. Past outings have in-

cluded a trip to the beach in Algoma, a baseball game, and visits to local businesses. Residents also proudly decorated a tree that Dimensions Living sponsored during the National Railroad Museum’s Polar Express holiday event.

Just like the residents, team members at Dimensions Living are encouraged to get involved with the community and participate in local programs, such as attending events with the Chamber. The organization often partners with animal rescues and is currently fostering a lovely puppy, including covering the adoption fee. During the summer, Dimensions Living has hosted a ribbon cutting with carnival activities to welcome the community to its back patio and show appreciation to staff and residents.

Dimensions Living does have locations outside of Green Bay, including a memory care community in Appleton, along with other cities throughout Wisconsin and Illinois.
