The Greater Green Bay Community Foundation and the Green Bay Packers Foundation are hosting this 24-hour, online community-wide giving day to highlight the work of 50 local nonprofits in Brown County. With minimum donations of \$10, anyone can contribute to support the work of participating nonprofits at <u>givebiggreenbay.org</u>. A \$250,000 grant from the Green Bay Packers Foundation established a matching pool of funds to ensure that every dollar donated will go further for bigger impact. Additional funds made available through the Greater Green Bay Community Foundation and other generous donors brings the match and incentive total to more than \$500,000. Since 2018, donors to Give BIG Green Bay have generated over \$13.5 million for local nonprofits.
