OSMS Adds Electromyography to Services Offered

GREEN BAY, WI (January 6, 2025) – Dr. Marie Walker, a Dual Board-Certified Physical Medicine & Rehabilitation Physician is joining the Orthopedic & Sports Medicine Specialists (OSMS) team starting on January 23, 2025, at their Green Bay Clinic. With Dr. Walker joining the team, OSMS now has added Electromyography (EMG/NCS) as a service for patients. Electromyography consists of an Electromyography Study (EMG) and a Nerve Conduction Velocity Study (NCV). The EMG measures the electrical activity of the muscles while the NCV measures the speed and intensity of the electrical signals that travel along the nerves.

Board-Certified in Physical Medicine & Rehabilitation and Electrodiagnostic Medicine, <u>Dr. Marie Walker</u>, a Neenah native, received her medical degree from the University of Wisconsin – Madison and completed her residency training at Mayo Clinic in Rochester, Minnesota.

Dr. Walker specializes in non-operative care of spine conditions and EMG/NCS. Conditions that Dr. Walker evaluates include back and neck pain, shoulder pain, hip pain, joint pain, carpal tunnel syndrome, sciatica, spinal cord injuries, torticollis, myofascial pain, cervical radiculopathy, lumbar radiculopathy, thoracic outlet syndrome, and spasticity, among other conditions.

Dr. Walker performs procedures including, but not limited to, EMGs, Botox for torticollis and spasticity, peripheral joint injections, carpal tunnel injections, trigger point injections, and bursa injections.
