Current Young Professionals announces 2022 Spring SOUP presenters

Green Bay, Wis. (May 12, 2022) - Current Young Professionals (CYP), a program of the Greater Green Bay Chamber, has announced the presenting projects for the 2022 Spring Support Of Urban Projects (SOUP) event during Current Week 2022.

SOUP is a forum in which community members can share ideas on how to enhance the quality of life in Greater Green Bay. Event attendees vote on the presented projects to award micro-grant funding to help the project succeed.

The 2022 Spring SOUP projects and presenters are:

- **Fostering Happy Soles** will be presented by Cheri Salmon of Foster the Village. The project's goal is to provide new shoes to the children fostered through the organization.
- No Butts About It, Green Bay will be presented by Kelly Reyer of the Fox-Wolf Watershed Alliance. The project's goal is to build awareness of cigarette trash/litter issues in the Fox-Wolf River Basin and beyond, as well as install cigarette bins in downtown Green Bay.
- **Pup-Up Dog Park on Broadway** will be presented by Brooke Hafs of On Broadway, Inc. The project's goal is to transform the vacant lot between Three Five and Creative Business Services into a pop-up dog park.
- **St. John's Holy Smokes** will be presented by Annika Osell on behalf of St. John's Ministries. The project's goal is to purchase supplies for the BBQ smoker trailer and secure food handling and safety certifications for those participating in the operation.
- **Urban Pollinator Gardens** will be presented by Shelby Woller of the Tank Park Neighborhood Association. The project's goal is to add a small to midsize pollinator garden to the Tank Park Neighborhood.

The 2022 Spring SOUP dinner will be held on Thursday, May 26, at 5 p.m. at the Stadium View Banquet Hall. The micro-grant awarded to the winning projects is funded by Alive & Kickin' Pizza Crust, KerberRose, and the funds raised by event attendance. The soup dinner options are donated by the Grounded Café, Plae Bistro, Stadium View, and Hey, Soup Sister. Bread is donated by Great Harvest Bread Co.

The SOUP event is a part of Brown County's and the City of Green Bay's official young professionals' week: Current Week 2022, presented by Fox Communities Credit Union and Green Bay Packers Give Back.
